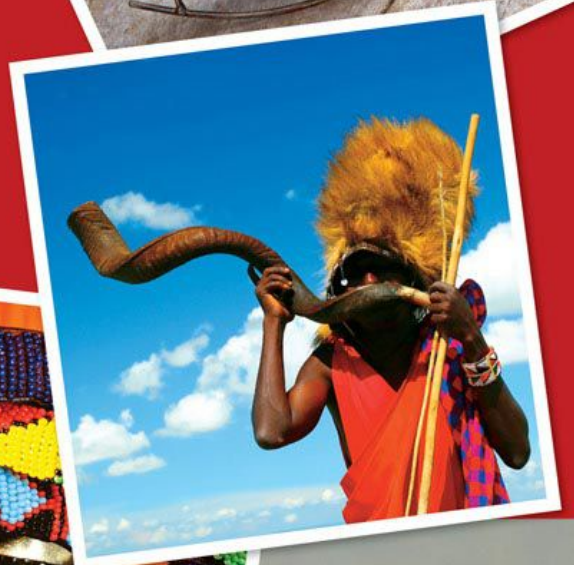


Kenya & Tanzania

LANGUAGE SPOKEN	Kiswahili is the National language, but English is widely spoken.
CURRENCY	Kenyan Shilling (KES) 1 USD = 100 KES; 100 KES = 65 INR Tanzanian Shilling (TZS) 1 USD = 1900 TZS.
